THE HARVEST:

The crop was hand-picked on the 2nd May, 2012. The fruit was sourced from selected rows of specific clones of pinot noir, grown and produced on the Glasnevin alluvial soils on Georges Road in the Waipara Valley, North Canterbury.

THE WINE:

---

Naturally fermented in a seasoned French oak puncheon and matured for nine months in a single seasoned French oak barrique to yield 225 litres. The wine is delightfully scented, supple and rich. It is a beautifully integrated wine, with vibrant cherry, spice, and savoury flavours. The finish is silky and seductive. Bottled unfinned and unfiltered.
